



# MUFFIN'S WESTERN HAT AND BANDANA

## SUPERVISION

**PATTERN PARROT** designs patterns and accessories for handmade felt animals which are **NOT** safety tested. Although safety joints and eyes are used in their making you are advised that it is **NOT A TOY**. Of course your creations can be enjoyed by children but it is suggested this is done through supervised play and its highly recommended that you perform regular checks to avoid potential hazards.

## WESTERN HAT : MATERIALS NEEDED

To make this hat you will need:

Brown felt 24 cm x 19cm


White felt 7cm x 5cm

Colour felt of your choice strip 1 cm x 23cm

Iron on interface 15cm x 27cm

Brown embroidery thread

Thin elastic to make a chin strap.



## TO MAKE THE MUFFIN'S WESTERN HAT

### RIM

You will need to cut two of the hat rims pieces from felt and two from the iron interface. Cut the interface rim slightly smaller on the outer edge so that it won't show at the outer seam. Iron on the interface to the top and bottom hat rim pieces.


Place the two rims together with the interface in between, using the embroidery thread and blanket stitch sew around the outer edge to join the two pieces together.

Place to one side while you make the crown.



## CROWN

To make the hat crown first match the two notches on the hat crown and hat top. The dip is placed at the front of the hat. Pin the top to the hat to the rim. Starting at the end of the strip, use embroidery thread and blanket stitch to join the upper edge of the hat crown strip to the top. When it is attached join the two ends of the strip together using overstitch.



## JOINING THE CROWN TO THE RIM

Place the crown open edge into the whole of the hat rim. Turn it over so you can see the underside of the hat, now either pin or hold in place while using over stitch and sewing thread to join the two edges together.

## DECORATING THE HAT

I decorated the hat by adding a band and bone

To make the bone simply cut around the shape template given. You will need two pieces. Then join the two pieces together using overstitch around the outer edge.

Add a hat band to the bottom of the crown. You will need a thin strip of your choice of coloured felt 1cm x 23cm. Pin the band to the hat placing the bone jauntily sticking out of the band. Sew the band on using overstitch along the upper and lower long edge then join the two ends of the strip together. You may wish to sew the bone to the hat to prevent it from sticking out so far.


After decorating the hat add an elastic chin strap to help hold it to your animals head.



## WESTERN BANDANA: MATERIALS NEEDED

To make this bandana you will need:

You choice of fabric, 28cm x 13cm



## TO MAKE MUFFIN'S WESTERN BANDANA




To make the bandana you will need to cut your piece on the fold to make a wide shallow triangle of fabric.

Simply hem around the edges using a double fold hem. You will need to trim the corners to remove the excess fabric from the hem.

With the triangle now hemmed you can fold and iron the bandana to your desired look.
